## **Cleaning The Inlet Filter**

Models: 520HN, 520PN, 330PN




## Tools needed:

- Pliers
- ▶ Bucket

## Removing inlet filter

- 1. Shut off the installer supplied cold water isolation valve to the heater. If one is not installed, install before proceeding.
- 2. Open the nearest hot water tap to drain the plumbing lines.
- 3. Position a bucket under the heater's water valve assembly to catch any water that may drain from the heater.
- 4. Remove the retaining clip located at base of water valve (Fig. 1, Num. 1).
- Remove the threaded bushing (Fig. 1, Num. 2) to access the cylindrical filter inside.
- 6. Remove filter, clean with water and inspect for damage.
- 7. If the filter is at all damaged, it should be replaced.
